



# Office Use Compounding Agreement

This agreement is for compliance with Georgia Board of Pharmacy Rule 480-11.02. This agreement is between Wedgewood Village Pharmacy, LLC ("Pharmacy") and the undersigned (Veterinarian).

**Pharmacy agrees that it shall:**

- I. Comply with federal and state laws, rules, regulations and practice standards applicable to a pharmacy preparing veterinary compounded medication, including United States Pharmacopeia guidelines;
- II. Maintain active licensure with the Georgia Board of Pharmacy;
- III. Comply with the provisions of subsections O.C.G.A.T 16, Ch 13 and T. 26, Ch. 4; and


**Veterinarian agrees that:**

- I. For any compounded preparation administered or dispensed to the patient, the compounded preparation's lot number and beyond-use-date shall be recorded in the patient's chart, medication order, or medication administration record;
- II. The compounded preparation may only be administered to the patient and may not be dispensed to the patient or sold to any other person or entity except for a case in which emergency dispensing is required

In the event of a preparation recall, the Pharmacy will contact the Veterinarian so that pet owners can be notified, if appropriate, and remaining preparations can be discarded or returned to the pharmacy.

In the event of an adverse reaction or to submit a complaint, pet owners and/or Veterinarians are encouraged to contact the Pharmacy with information regarding the nature of the reaction or dissatisfaction so that the situation can be remediated, if possible, and future events can be avoided.

This agreement excludes controlled substances.
